Every winter, Yellowstone closes its roads to ordinary traffic and the crowds disappear. What is left is steam rising off the snow, bison in the meadows, and Old Faithful erupting for a handful of people instead of a few thousand. This is the week to see it.

YOUR DAY BY DAY

DAY ONE Saturday January 16	Arrive in Salt Lake City Your winter escape begins in Utah. Plan to land at Salt Lake City International before 1:00 pm, where your transfer downtown is arranged and waiting. Once you have settled into the hotel, meet your local guide for an unhurried tour of the city and its landmarks, including historic Temple Square. This evening the group comes together for a welcome dinner, and by dessert you will have met the people you are about to spend the week with. OVERNIGHT Sheraton Salt Lake City Hotel, UT MEALS Dinner
DAY TWO Sunday January 17	North to West Yellowstone This morning you leave Salt Lake City and travel north into Idaho, with a comfortable stop for lunch on your own along the route. The afternoon is the scenery you came for, rolling through the Island Park area toward West Yellowstone, your base for the next two nights. Dinner is included at a local restaurant, then the evening is yours to wander the town. OVERNIGHT Starlite Yellowstone, West Yellowstone, MT MEALS Breakfast, Dinner
DAY THREE Monday January 18	Yellowstone by Snowcoach Today is the heart of the trip. In winter the park interior is reachable only by snowcoach, so you climb aboard a heated coach with big windows and an experienced guide who knows exactly where to look. You will stop along the Madison River, walk the boardwalks at Fountain Paint Pots, and spend real time at Old Faithful with no rush at all. Lunch is included, and the ride back adds more picture stops. Optional add on: snowmobile tour to Old Faithful, \$250.00 per person. DAY FOUR Tuesday January 19	Elk Refuge, Grand Teton & Jackson The Tetons do not ease into view, they simply appear, rising straight out of the valley floor. You travel south with photo stops overlooking the Snake River, then arrive in Jackson, Wyoming for free time and lunch on your own in a western town that has kept its character. Then the moment most guests talk about afterward: a horse drawn sleigh ride into the National Elk Refuge, right in among a herd of thousands. Your guide explains how settlement of the valley changed the elk migration and why this refuge matters so much today. OVERNIGHT Elk Country Inn, Jackson, WY MEALS Breakfast

A Free Day in Jackson, Wyoming

January 20

DAY SIX

Utah Olympic Park & Salt Lake City

Thursday
January 21

Leave Jackson this morning and travel through western Wyoming, past silver streams, soaring peaks, and wide meadows. You will drive the rugged Snake River Canyon with a stop in Star Valley, then reach Evanston for lunch on your own.

The afternoon brings a guided tour of Utah Olympic Park, host of the 2002 Winter Games and still a training ground today. You will see the Utah Ski and Olympic Museum, three Nordic jumps, and the bobsled and luge track, which holds some of the fastest ice on earth. Late afternoon you return to Salt Lake City for a farewell dinner with the group.
