Charleston Historic District, Carriages and Hamilton

Charleston in February is a well-kept secret: mild days, quiet streets, and the city's winter camellias in bloom. This quick getaway is built to soak up the best of it without a single worry about driving, parking, or planning. We'll board our motorcoach in Myrtle Beach at 8:00 AM and settle in for an easy ride down the coast, arriving in the heart of Charleston's historic district by mid-morning.

Your first stop is the famous Charleston City Market, four blocks of local artisans, sweetgrass basket weavers, and Lowcountry treats. Enjoy free time to browse, explore the surrounding streets, and grab lunch on your own at one of the many nearby favorites.

After lunch, we'll see the city the way it was meant to be seen: by horse-drawn carriage. Your guided carriage tour winds through cobblestone streets and past antebellum mansions, hidden gardens, and centuries of stories told by guides who know them all. Afterward, there's a little more time to wander before we head to the DoubleTree by Hilton in North Charleston to check in, freshen up, and put our feet up for a bit.

Tonight is the main event. We'll gather for an included dinner, then head to the North Charleston Performing Arts Center for HAMILTON, the revolutionary musical that has taken the world by storm. This is the closing night of the Charleston run, and you're in Orchestra seating, right where you want to be for every note. When the curtain falls, your coach is waiting to take you back to the hotel. No traffic, no parking garage, no stress.

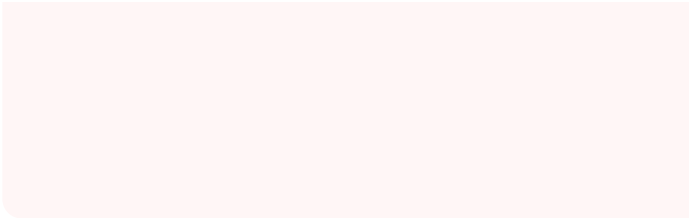
